Core Studies

- 1) **Qaida** – Correct recognition, pronunciation and recitation of letters and words
- 2) **Holy Qur'an** – Recitation with correct implementation of tajweed rulings
- 3) **Hifdh** – Memorisation of the Holy Qur'an

Islamiyaat

- 1) **Adiyah:** Is the practical aspect of Fiqh. Including the readings in daily acts such as entering and leaving the mosque. Also it is learning actual short sayings of the Prophet (saw) both in English and Arabic and also singing in the praise of Allah (swt) and His Prophet (saw) to create love and awareness.
- 2) **Fiqh:** This deals with the theory aspect of the curriculum, including daily rituals and general knowledge.
- 3) **Aqaaid:** This is the understanding of the Deen e.g. Five Pillars and also the understanding of Tawheed and Risalat.
- 4) **Adaab:** This is the conduct of an individual concerning manners and etiquette. Also it includes the understanding of good ethical behaviour within a variety of situations. These include:-
 - i) Personal Issues – Hygiene, cleanliness, personal outlook, attitude & spirituality
 - ii) Social Issues – Parent-Child relationships etc
 - iii) Community Issues – Drugs & Crime etc
- 5) **History:** This concerns the main historical events and also historical figures within the ummah. Recounting through stories (waqiahs) & commemorating special days.
- 6) **Languages:** Learning basic Arabic & Urdu; reading, writing and understanding.
