giftaid it Noor Ul Islam Mosque Gift Aid Scheme

Gift Aid is a Government scheme that allows registered charities such as Noor ul Islam Mosque to claim back tax you've paid to the UK Government. The Gift Aid claimed on your donation is thus tax you've paid which the Government allows us to reclaim.

For every £1 you give to the Mosque, the government will give 28p (28%) from the taxes you have already paid. So the Mosque in total will receive £1.28.

Note: Gift Aid costs you **nothing**. Money is reclaimed from tax you've paid. When you make a declaration, all your donations in future will also be topped up with Gift Aid and the mosque can claim for any donations made by you for the past 6 vears.

We are unfortunately unable to claim Gift Aid on donations made during the year where no tax was paid. A UK tax payer is someone who falls within the following categories:

- Tax is taken from your wages or salary before you receive it (see your payslip).
- You have taxable savings or income from investments such as stocks and shares or the sale of property.
- You are required to complete a Self Assessment form each year.

If you are a higher tax rate payer we can initially only claim back 28% of your donation as Gift Aid. However, you can ensure Noor ul Islam Mosque receives back the difference between this and the higher rate of tax by guoting code **XR54591** on your Self Assessment form.

Tax claimed by the charity

- The Mosque will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The Mosque will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay to the Mosque an additional 3p on every £1 you • give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the Mosque does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
