Haq Mahar: _____(Monetary Value)

Note:The Gift of Mahar is a right of the bride and should be given with proper adab (courtesy). It is now a custom to give a derogatory gift of mahr to the bride. (e.g £100, RS 32 etc.) This is against the ethics of Islam, a stain on the noble tradition of Islam and denial of the rights that Islam has established for women. Mahr is one of the main Islamic conditions that allow a couple to marry and should be fixed before the Nikah day and given due importance. The negotiations of mahr gift should NOT take place on the day of the nikah.

If bride is a divorcee, the mosque must be provided with proof of divorce. Please speak to the Imam prior to the ceremony.
